

Getting Started with hoopla!

About

Hoopla is a streaming and downloading service offering library patrons access to videos, music, eBooks, audiobooks, comics and TV shows without having to worry about late fees or lines.

A total of 5 titles can be borrowed each month with the Orillia Public Library on each library account. Your account resets at the beginning of each month.

There are unlimited copies of all products, meaning you don't have to wait for your items to become available!

You don't have to worry about late fees. Once your loan period is over, the eBook, audiobook, album, movie, TV show or comic will automatically remove itself.

To start using items from hoopla you need an internet connection and a library card.

Your loan periods vary depending on what content you are borrowing:

- Movies and TV Shows: 72 hours/3 days
- Albums: 7 days/1 week
- eBooks, audiobooks and comics: 21 days/3 weeks

Definitions

<u>Streaming</u> is one of the ways that hoopla offers its content. Content is not downloaded onto your device but instead is offered on a browser and internet connected device for constant use.

<u>Download</u> is the second method in which hoopla offers its content. Content is saved on your device in order to offer offline use. This is available by using the hoopla mobile app

<u>Hoopla mobile app</u> is a free app downloaded onto a mobile device from the Google or Apple app stores. It allows you to use the items you borrowed when not connected to the internet.

<u>eBooks</u> are digital versions of paper books that have been optimized to read on a screen. You can download them on your mobile app or read via streaming on your devices.

<u>Audiobooks</u> are recorded readings of books. You can download them on your mobile app or listen via streaming on your devices.

<u>TV Shows</u> are series offered by hoopla. You do not borrow the entire series but instead browse through the episodes and select individual ones to borrow. You can add a show to your favourites and make your way through the episodes.



Software

On your computer, you need an internet connection and a web browser which will allow you to stream music, books, TV shows and movies. You will only be able to stream content on your computer.

On a mobile device (smartphone for tablet) you will need to download the hoopla app. You can either stream or download content on your mobile device. The app is available on Android, iOS and Amazon products. You can get the full list of supported devices on the Hoopla website, or by talking to your Librarian.

Your Account

You need to create an account in order to borrow and use hoopla content.

Create Your Account

Computer

- 1. Go to www.hoopladigital.com
- 2. Select **Get Started** in the centre of the screen.
- 3. Select the **Sign Up** tab from the popup window.
- 4. Fill out the form and use the same information to login.

Hoopla Digital mobile app on Android

- 1. Open the Hoopla Digital app on your device.
- 2. Select **Sign Up** on the top right of the login bars.
- 3. Select Orillia Public Library and complete the Account Information Form.

Hoopla Digital app on Apple

- 1. Open the Hoopla Digital app on your device.
- 2. Select Sign Up on the bottom centre of the login bars.
- 3. Select Orillia Public Library and complete the Account Information Form.

Use Your Account

Computer

- 1. Select **Settings** from the top right.
 - a. Update your email or change your password.
 - b. Turn on kids mode to limit only content appropriate for those up to 12 years old.
 - c. Choose to track or not track your history.
 - d. Choose **Select** beside the **Recommendations** field to adjust your favourites. The more accurate your selection here, the more accurate the recommendations given by hoopla will be.



- 2. Hover over **My Hoopla** from the top left to get a drop down menu.
 - a. Find the items you have checked out under **Currently Borrowed**.
 - b. Find items, authors and such that you have flagged with a heart under Favorites.
 - c. Find your past borrows under **History**. You can clear that history by selecting **Clear History** on the top right.

Hoopla Digital app on Android

- 1. Select the gear icon (located on the top right) and select **Settings**.
 - a. Turn on kids mode to limit to content appropriate to those under 12.
 - b. Turn your history off or on
 - с. .
 - d. Select Recommendation Settings to pick your favourite genres.
- 2. Select Borrowed to see the items you currently have out.
- 3. Select History to see what items you have borrowed in the past.
- 4. Select Favourites to see the items you have added to your favourites.

Hoopla Digital app on Apple

- 1. Select the gear icon (located on the top right).
 - a. Turn on kids mode show only content appropriate to those under 12.
 - b. Select **Recommendation Settings** to select the genres that interest you so hoopla can make recommendations.
 - c. Select **Personal Settings** to update your email and password, and to change your History setting.
 - d. Select Library Settings to update your library card, pin and library system.
 - e. Select Notification Settings to edit your personal notifications.
- 2. Select the heart on the top right to see your favourites.

Browsing and Searching

Browser

- 1. Browse by hovering over **Browse** on the top left. A drop down menu will show you all available formats. Select the one you want.
 - i. Each format will allow you to choose between **Recommended**, **Featured**, **Popular** and **Categories**.
 - a. There is a filter tool on the right just below the rotating carousel. You can filter by order, audience, release and excluding fields.
 - b. Watch the rotating carousel to get recommendations.
- 2. Select **Search** from the top left.
 - a. Search for titles, people, series or keywords.
 - b. Watch the *Trending searches* below the search bar to see what is popular.

From the home page you can browse content by format:



- A. Select Tap here to view more.
 - i. Select **Genres**, **Recommended**, **Featured** or **Popular** to change what is displayed.
- B. Select the format you are looking for from the top of the screen.
- C. Select the search icon on the top right of the screen to find a search bar.
 - i. A trending searches list will appear below the search bar.

Streaming

All content used on a computer is offered by streaming. Your computer DOES NOT download the content but instead offers it to you via the internet. You need to remain connected to the internet for continuous use.

- 1. Hover over the borrowed item.
- 2. Select the blue **Play** button.
- 3. The item will open in the browser window.

Downloading

Using the app, you can download borrowed items onto your devices. You can then disconnect from the internet once downloaded and use the items offline. The items return themselves on their due date.


- 1. Select the item you want to download from your account.
- 2. Select Download to your device.

Using...

eBooks

Browser

- 1. Hover over the item you want to use.
- 2. Select the blue **Play** button. The book will open and look something like this: ☐ The Lightning Thief (Movie Tie-In Edition) ① Tr △ Q II ③





- 3. Use the arrows on the bottom of the page to turn the pages.
- 4. Select 0 on the top right to report an error.
- 5. Select ^{Tr} on the top right to change the font size, font type and colour theme.
- 6. Select $\stackrel{\triangle}{=}$ on the top right to change the justification, layout, margin and line spacing.
- 7. Select $^{\circ}$ on the top right to search for something within the text.
- 8. Select Mon the top right to see all of your bookmarks and the table of contents.
- 9. Select \bigotimes on the top right to close your book.
- 10. Select \bowtie on the top left to create a bookmark.

Android

- 1. Select the item you want to launch from your account.
- 2. Select the blue **Read** button and the book will open.
 - a. Slide your fingers left and right to turn the pages.
 - b. Select ≡ from the bottom left to get the table of contents and bookmarks summary.
 - c. Select \bigcirc from the bottom centre-left to search within the text.
 - d. Select Aa from the bottom centre to change the font size and type.
 - e. Select 🗝 from the bottom centre-right to change the background.
 - f. Select ² from the bottom centre-right to adjust the book format.
 - g. Select the ribbon on the top right to create a bookmark.

Apple

- 1. Select the item you want to launch from your account.
- 2. Select the blue **Read** button and the book will open.
 - a. Scroll and turn pages using your fingers.
 - b. Select 🗮 from the top right to get your table of contents and bookmarks summary.
 - c. Select \bigcirc from the top right to search the text for something.
 - d. Select \square from the top right to create a bookmark.
 - e. Select Aa from the bottom right to change the font type and size.
 - f. Select ⁽¹⁾ from the bottom right to change the background colour.
 - g. Select ⁽²⁾/₍₂₎ from the bottom right to change the page formatting.

Audiobooks

Browser

- 1. Hover over the book cover.
- 2. Select the blue **Play** button and the audiobook will open a toolbar on the bottom of your browser window. This is where you can pause, play and adjust the volume.



- 3. Select \land from the bottom left to open up the book details and the full media player.
 - a. Select \square from the top right. Your bookmarks will show under the progress bar.

Android

- 1. Select the item you want to launch from your account.
- 2. Use the navigation options on the bottom to pause, play, fast forward or rewind.
- 3. Select the ribbon on the top right to create and see your bookmark list.
- 4. Select the stop watch icon on the top right to set a sleep timer.
- 5. Hoopla will save your spot so you can close the window and return to the recording and pick up at the same spot.



Apple

- 1. Select the item you want to launch from your account.
- 2. Select the blue **Play** button.
- 3. Use the navigation options on the bottom to pause, play, fast forward or rewind.
- 4. Select the ribbon on the top right to create and see your bookmark list.
- 5. Select **Sleep Timer** on the bottom left to set a sleep timer.
- 6. Hoopla will save your spot so you can close the window and return to the recording and pick up at the same spot.

Albums

Browser

- 1. Hover over the album cover.
- 2. Select the blue **Play** button and the album will open a toolbar on the bottom of your browser window. Here you can pause, play and adjust the volume.
- 3. Select ^ from the bottom left to open up the book details and the full media player.
 - a. Use the navigation menu to jump through tracks, activate shuffle and repeat.
 - b. Browse through the track list and double click the title you want to play.

Android

- 1. Select the item you want to launch from your account.
- 2. Select the blue **Play** button below the album cover.
- 3. Use the controls below the album cover to start, skip, replay and shuffle the music.
- 4. Select the menu icon on the top left to see the track list and select the song you want to play.

Apple

- 1. Select the item you want to launch from your account.
- 2. Select the blue **Play** button below the album cover.
- 3. Use the controls below the album covert to start, skip, replay and shuffle the music.
- 4. Select the arrow on the top left to return to the item description page.

TV Shows

Browser

- 1. Hover over the TV series and select the blue **See Episodes** button.
- 2. Find the borrowed episode and select the blue **Play** button.
- 3. The episode will launch in your browser.
- 4. Use the navigation buttons on the bottom to stop, play, rewind and fast forward.
- 5. Hoopla will save your spot so you can close the window and return to the episode later.
- 6. Use the progress bar on the bottom to navigate.

Android

- 1. Select the item you want to borrow from your account.
- 2. Select the **Play** button.



- 3. Use the navigation buttons on the bottom to pause, play, fast forward and rewind.
- 4. Hoopla will save your spot so you can close the window and return to the episode or film and pick up at the same spot.

Apple

- 1. Select the item you want to borrow from your account.
- 2. Select the **Play** button
- 3. Use the navigation buttons on the bottom to pause, play, fast forward and rewind.
- 4. Hoopla will save your spot so you can close the window and return to the episode or film and pick up at the same spot.

Movies

Browser

- 1 Hover over the TV series and select the blue **See Episodes** button.
- 2 Find the borrowed episode and select the blue **Play** button.
- 3 Use the navigation buttons on the bottom to stop, play, rewind and fast forward.
- 4 Hoopla will save your spot so you can close the window and return to the episode later.
- 5 Use the progress bar on the bottom to navigate.
- 6 Hoopla will save your spot so you can close the window and return to the same part of the film when you return.

Android

- 1. Select the item you want to borrow from your account and select the **Play** button.
- 2. Use the navigation buttons on the bottom to pause, play, fast forward and rewind.
- 3. Hoopla will save your spot so you can close the window and return to the episode or film and pick up at the same spot.

Apple

- 1. Select the item you want to borrow from your account and select the **Play** button.
- 2. Use the navigation buttons on the bottom to pause, play, fast forward and rewind.
- 3. Hoopla will save your spot so you can close the window and return to the episode or film and pick up at the same spot.

Comics

Browser

- 1. Hover over the book cover and select the blue **Play** button. The comic will open in the next window.
- 2. Use the arrows on the middle left and right of the screen to turn the pages.
- 3. Click on any panel to enter action mode. You will read panel by panel instead of page by page. Click on the panel again to exit the action mode.
- 4. Select from the bottom right to open your menu.
 - a. Select exit reader to close the comic.



- b. Select comic details to get more information about the issue.
- c. Select help if you are stuck.

- d. Select report error to report an error.
- e. Select page list to jump to other pages.

Android

- 1. Select the item you want from your account.
- 2. Select the blue Read button below the book cover and the comic will open.
- 3. Slide your fingers left and right to turn the pages.
- 4. Tap the screen twice to enter action view.
- 5. Use the progress bar on the bottom to jump to a new page.

Apple

- 1. Select the item you want from your account.
- 2. Select the blue Read button below the book cover and the comic will open.
- 3. Slide your fingers left and right to navigate the pages.
- 4. Select Done in the top left corner to close the comic.
- 5. Tap the screen twice to enter action view.
- 6. Select Pages from the top left to jump through the comic book.

Related Content

On the bottom of each item description page you will find a **People Who Borrowed This Title Also Borrowed** list and **Related Titles Lists**. There is also a list of similar authors or artists included on these pages.

Hoopla makes recommendations based on your favourite genres. To update or help get more accurate recommendations:

- 1. Select Settings from the top right.
- 2. Go to the bottom and select the white **Select** button beside the **Recommendations** field.
- 3. Choose your favourite genres in all available formats.
- 4. Select the white **Done** button on the top right.
